Thekwini TVET College, invites tenders for the above mentioned project. The duration of the project will be 36 months (3 years). Tenderers must be registered as **Grade 3SF or Higher** with the CIDB.

Prequalification: Only tenderers who meet the following prequalification criteria may respond:

Only tenderers who have the following are eligible to submit tenders/ proposals:

- Tenderers registered as Grade 3SF or Higher with the CIDB (proof of registration to be attached)
- letter of good standing Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COIDA) or an application letter with a stamp from Department of Labour
