#### NCV - National Certificate Vocational

The National Certificate Vocational "NCV" is a programme at each of the National Qualification Framework (NQF) levels of study. It will take three years to complete the full (NQF L2/3/4) qualification. Designed as high quality, high knowledge programmes, providing out of school youth and post grade 9 learners with the option to jump-start their careers by beginning at (Grade 10) Level 2. The NCV qualifications will involve practical and workshop type training. Students who have completed an NCV qualification will be eligible for employment in their chosen fields of study or articulation to Higher Education institutions.

#### MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

16 years or older and a pass in Grade 9 or higher/ or an NQF level 1 qualification.

## **COURSES OFFERED**

# Engineering & Related Design: Automotive Repair & Maintenance

This deals with the fundamentals of vehicle tech nology and equips students with the necessary confidence to perform tasks related to vehicle components-engines, gearboxes, fuel systems, body components and electronics.

# Engineering & Related Design: Fitting & Turning

Fitting and turning deals with the various process es involved in making or producing components required in the manufacturing, engineering and technological environment.

#### **Electrical Infrastructure Construction**

This programme covers both heavy and light cur rent fields. Learners are eligible to access careers in Electrical Engineering, domestic/Industrial/elec trical maintenance, digital electronics, instrumen tation and self-supporting enterprises.

#### Information Technology and Computer Science: Software design and development

Information technology and computer science programme covers the interpretation of software applications, networking, I.T principles and data processing.

# Information Technology and Computer Science : Programming and Robotics

This programme will provide a solid foundation and essential skills in programming, specializing in robotics and industrial automation, engineering graphics and electronic concepts. Inclusive of skills training in the fields of manufacturing automation, vehicle autonomy, security device hardware, infrastructure automation and other programming related products.

#### Hospitality

This learning programme covers sectors of the tourism and hospitality industries. It provides learners with marketable skills to enter the hospi tality industry placing emphasis on the importance of client satisfaction for revenue generation.

#### Tourism

Covers skills such as map reading, forex conver sions and tour guidance. It also concepts such as sustainability, heritage and conservation and helps to form the foundation of successful tourism practice.

## **Transport & Logistics**

Logistics is the planning, organisation, manage ment, execution and control of freight transport operations. It integrates individual transport acts to door-to-door supply chains, determining the efficiency of freight transport.

#### Office Administration

This programme involves planning, organizing and the execution of office duties and administration the business environment.

## **Education and Development**

This qualification is designed to provide both theory and practice in the field of Early childhood development. It will provide students with the practical component of study which may be offered in a real work space environment.

## Pre-Vocational Learning Programme

The PLP is a bridging programme for grade 9 learners who have not met the minimum require ments for entry to specific NCV programmes. This programme gives the learner the opportunity to improve their knowledge and skills. It is geared to assist learners with improving their marks, thus en abling entry to the NCV programme of their choice.

### REPORT 191 ('N' COURSES) AND OTHER PROGRAMMES

The NATED / Report 191 programmes are delivered under the auspices of the Department of Higher Education and Training and quality assured by QCTO. The programmes consist of 18 months theo retical studies at College and 18 months relevant practical application in work places. Engineering studies range from N4 – N6 while Business and Utility Studies range from N4 – N6. Engineering Study Courses are trimester programmes and Business Study Courses are semester programmes.

Duration: 1 Year for N4 - N6 Engineering Studies

3 Years (18 months theoretical studies + 18 months' workplace application) for N4 – N6 Business and Utility Studies

**Qualification:** N Diploma Admission Requirements:

Engineering Studies - Grade 12 pass (N2/N3 admission- dependent on Mathematics and Science marks)

Business Studies - Grade 12 pass for N4 admission. Bursaries are available for financially and

academically qualifying students. Terms and Conditions apply to admission requirements, bursaries and other enrolment and registration procedures.
